2014 TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The Annual Greater Roanoke Area USBC Youth Championship Tournament is open to any sanctioned USBC bowler within the jurisdiction of the Greater Roanoke Area USBC Association. All Youth bowlers must have a USBC card before entry into the tournament. Final closing date will be March 1, 2014.
2. Tournament shall consist of four (4) bowler team event, two (2) bowlers double event and individual event. Teams may be all girls, all boys, or mixed. Scholarships will be awarded on a basis of one for each eight entries in each of the two class divisions and all events.
3. Averages will be taken as of December 31, 2013. They will be based on a minimum of fifteen (15) games. Bowlers bowling in more than one league must use the highest average held on December 31, 2013. This includes any Adult/Youth league in which they bowl. In case a bowler does not have a 15 game average on January 1, 2014 they may count the games up to the time scheduled to bowl but averages must be taken the week the 15<sup>th</sup> game average is bowled. The bowlers coach must certify this average before the bowler will be permitted to bowl. Bowlers who still do not have a 15 game average may enter the tournament but must bowl scratch. This means zero (0) handicap.
4. The bowler's coach must sign the entry form to verify that the bowler is USBC sanctioned and that the averages on the entry form are correct along with a current standing sheet.
5. All entry fees must accompany the entry form. Fees not paid in full will be returned and the entry will be declared void. No entry fee shall be returned after the closing date. All entries must be completed listing full names. Entries not having all names will be returned.
6. Bowlers must enter both singles and doubles to be eligible to bowl either one. Single and double entrants do not have to bowl in the team event. Team entrants do not have to bowl in the single and double events.
7. All bowlers will bowl three (3) games in each event. Bowlers may bowl more than once in singles and doubles.
8. Doubles shall be bowled first followed immediately by the singles event. There will be no break or lane change between the doubles and singles events.
9. Handicap shall be 90% of the difference of the individual average of 200. Tournament will be divided into two class divisions as follows:

	<u>CLASS B</u>	<u>CLASS A</u>
Team	560 and Below	561 and Over
Doubles	280 and Below	281 and Over
Singles	140 and Below	141 and Over

10. Should a substitute's average affect the total teams average and class, the team shall be automatically put into the proper class. Substitutes must check into the office at least one half hour before scheduled to bowl.
11. Teams and Doubles will bowl in the order shown on the entry form. Substitutes will be permitted only in the same line up position of the original entrant. Violators of this rule will be disqualified. No changes will be made except by the Tournament Committee.
12. Absentee scores will not be allowed. Late bowlers shall receive zero (0) for all frames missed. This applies during the game as well as at the beginning of the game. Score for late arrivals shall begin with the frame being bowled when the bowler starts to bowl. No substitutions will be made after the game starts except in case of emergency.
13. Any appeal or protest regarding a decision of the tournament director, official or score must be confirmed in writing to USBC no later than 72 hours after the decision is made. If the appeal is not received within this time, the decision will stand as is.
14. Bowlers will not be allowed to use any type of tobacco or alcoholic products during USBC activities. Also no form of gambling or obscene gestures will be allowed. Bowlers are not allowed to wear hats or head gear during the tournament. There will be no warnings. Bowlers will be disqualified.
