## Multi Association Championship Tournament

1. USBC Membership: Entrants must be a South Boston, Greater Roanoke Area, or Lynchburg Area USBC member as of January 1, 2024.
2. AVERAGES: Entrants will use their highest USBC certified adult league average based on a minimum of 21 games or more for the 2022-2023 season, whether winter or summer. If no last season average, use the highest April 12, 2024 certified league average with 21 games or more. THE 10 - PIN RULE IS IN EFFECT. IF YOUR AVERAGE IS 10 PINS HIGHER ON APRIL 13, 2024 THAN LAST YEAR, YOU MUST USE THE APRIL 13, 2024 AVERAGE. IT IS THE BOWLERS RESPONSIBILITY TO REPORT HIS/HER HIGHER AVERAGE. Written verification of April 13th average, signed by the League Secretary or standing sheet must be submitted with the entry form or participant will use 230 average. The Tournament Manager must verify the entering average of all winners by use of a previous season's local association yearbook, Winlabs, final average sheets if no yearbook published; or written verification if participant used April 13th or summer average.
3. CHECK-IN: All bowlers must check in with the tournament office 30 minutes prior to bowling time. ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN APRIL 13, 2023. ANY ENTRIES RECEIVED AFTER THE DEADLINE WILL BE RETURNED.
4. HANDICAP: Handicap shall be $90 \%$ of the difference between bowlers average and 230. Bowlers must enter Handicap events in order to bowl Scratch events.
5. ENTRY: A bowler who enters the Doubles event must also enter the Singles Event \& vice versa. Singles will be bowled first and bowlers will not change lanes for Singles and Doubles event.
6. DIVISIONS: There will be an Open Divisions in all of the events.
7. ENTRY / RE-ENTRY: A bowler may bowl more than once in Singles \& Doubles but can only cash once in the Singles event. In the Doubles event a bowler can only cash once with the same partner. Re-entries will be accepted if lanes are available.
8. SUBSTITUTES: Substitutes are allowed. No rearranging of partner will be permitted.
9. LATE ARRIVALS: Bowlers arriving late may bowl. Frames missed will be zero. The score will state with the frame in which the bowler is ready to bowl. No blind score is allowed for missed frames.
10. PROTESTS: Any protest affecting eligibility or playing rules must be confirmed in writing to the tournament manager within 72 hours. Rulings from tournament manager will be given within seven calendar days of protest being received.
11. NO FOOD OR BEVERAGES WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE BOWLING AREA.
12. BOWLING CIRCLE: Only bowlers and tournament officials will be permitted in the bowling area. (NO FRIENDS, FAMILY, CHILDREN OR SPECTATORS ALLOWED IN BOWLING AREA.)
13. SCORING: The overhead monitors will be used as the official scores. Each bowler is responsible for the accuracy of their score. If an error should occur on the monitor, a Tournament Official shall be contacted to make any changes in the overhead monitors. Game scores should be transferred from the overhead monitors to printed recap sheets.
14. PRACTICE: There is to be TEN minutes practice on your assigned lanes the day of the tournament. Lane assignments will be made by Tournament Manager.
15. ATTIRE: Members are required to wear suitable attire. NO SHORT SHORTS OR HALTER TOPS WILL BE ALLOWED. This will be at the Tournament Chairperson's discretion and any bowler may be asked to change attire before bowling.
16. The Tournament Manger and co-managers shall decide any questions not covered above.
17. All six games bowled the same shift.
